Scripture reminds us that "righteousness and justice are the foundation of God's throne" (Psalm 89:14), showing that lasting peace is not secured by strength alone but by the transformation of hearts. As both history and faith reveal, security and justice carry a weight that is not just physical or political, but deeply moral and spiritual—requiring wisdom, compassion, and the courage to uphold what is right, even at a cost.
