📄 Intellectual Property

- ◆ Proprietary code 💻
- ◆ Engineering plans, product designs 🔧
- ◆ Unreleased creative drafts 🎨

👥 People & Clients

- ◆ Personnel changes 🚫
- ◆ Client rosters 📁
- ◆ Personal info — even if known casually 🧑

📷 Visual Content

- ◆ Job sites, layouts, prototypes
- ◆ Behind-the-scenes tools & methods 🧰
- ◆ Cloud-synced devices = silent leaks ☁️🔒

📱 Device & Infrastructure Use

- ◆ Phones or laptops you don't own 📱
- ◆ Work-issued devices with managed service plans 📶
- ◆ Communications via employer-controlled servers 🖥️
- ◆ Corporate Wi-Fi or private network hubs 📶
- ◆ Files stored or synced to third-party clouds ☁️

💬 Private Conversations

- ◆ Words shared in confidence 🗣️
- ◆ Insider knowledge shared informally 🗨️
