- ☒ Share the Gospel – We are called to make disciples. (Matthew 28:19-20)
- ☒ Trust His Plan – Even in uncertainty, He is in control. (Proverbs 3:5-6)
- ☒ Use Your Gifts – God created us for a purpose. (Colossians 3:23)

Living in God's will is not about waiting for a sign—it's about taking daily steps of faith. When we seek Him first (Matthew 6:33), He will guide our steps.
