- 1. Seek Christ Daily: Make time for prayer, Scripture, and meditation.
- 2. Share Your Faith: Bring others to Christ by sharing the hope you have in Him.
- 3. Live with Obedience and Purpose: Align your actions with Christ's teachings and pursue eternal life wholeheartedly.
- 4. Avoid Distractions: Keep Christ at the center, with everything else in its proper place.
- Run toward Christ with all your heart—He is the way, the truth, and the life. Focus your efforts on knowing Him better, living out your faith, and helping others do the same.
