

🙏 The First Requirement of a Pastor: Prayer

🏠 A House of Prayer

Jesus declared: "My house shall be called a house of prayer" (Isaiah 56:7; Matthew 21:13).

Whether it's a cathedral 🏰, a hospital chapel 🏥, or a hut on a mountainside 🏠 — the true purpose of God's house is prayer.

➡ If the church is to be a house of prayer, then its shepherd must be a man of prayer.

✗ Without prayer, a pastor becomes a performer.

☑ With prayer, he becomes a vessel.

📖 Biblical Qualifications

Scripture gives clear requirements for pastors (also called elders or overseers):

◆ 1 Timothy 3:1–7 — Above reproach, sober-minded, hospitable, able to teach, not greedy, managing his household well.

◆ Titus 1:5–9 — Blameless, faithful in marriage, not arrogant or quick-tempered, holding firmly to sound doctrine.

◆ 1 Peter 5:2–3 — Shepherding willingly, humbly, and as an example to the flock.

These describe character 🌟 and doctrine 📖 — but beneath them lies something unspoken: 🙏 dependence on God through prayer.

🌿 The Apostolic Pattern

The apostles knew the foundation of ministry:

"We will give ourselves continually to prayer, and to the ministry of the word." (Acts 6:4).

- ◆ Before they preached, they prayed.
- ◆ Before they appointed leaders, they prayed.
- ◆ Before they sent missionaries, they prayed.
- ◆ When they suffered, they prayed.

For them, prayer was not an accessory 🛒.

It was the engine 🚗.

? Why Prayer First?

1 Prayer aligns the pastor with God's will. ✝

Without it, sermons become opinions.

2 Prayer strengthens the pastor for spiritual battles. ✝️
Without it, he stands unarmed.

3 Prayer intercedes for the people. 🐑
Without it, the flock is uncovered.

4 Prayer humbles the heart. ❤️
Without it, pride will destroy the man and the ministry.

🔥 Leonard Ravenhill once said:

"No man is greater than his prayer life. The pastor who is not praying is playing; the people who are not praying are straying."

☑ A Simple Conclusion

The world 🌍 may measure pastors by charisma, education 🎓, or success 🏆.

But heaven 📖 measures them by whether they pray.

The most basic requirement of a pastor is not eloquence 🗣️, not leadership style 🗣️, not even formal training 🏫 — but a life anchored in prayer.

For if the church is to be a house of prayer, then its shepherd must be, first and foremost, a man on his knees.
