- THE MOUNTAIN OF PROVISION: FROM MORIAH TO CALVARY
- "On the mount of the LORD it shall be provided." (Genesis 22:14)

Did you know that the mountain where Abraham almost sacrificed Isaac is tied to the place where Jesus was crucified? Same mountain region. Same promise. Same God — who always keeps His word.

1 ABRAHAM & ISAAC: THE TEST 6

God told Abraham: "Take your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love... and offer him." (Genesis 22) So Abraham and Isaac climb Mount Moriah. Isaac carries the wood. There's no ram in sight. But just as Abraham lifts the knife, God stops him — and provides a ram caught in the thicket. "Red God's name is revealed: Jehovah-Jireh — The LORD Will Provide.

2 THE TEMPLE: SACRIFICES CONTINUE 1

Centuries later, Solomon built the Temple on Mount Moriah (2 Chronicles 3:1).

Every day, people brought lambs to be sacrificed — but none could fully pay for sin.
It was a shadow of what was to come — a better Lamb.

CALVARY: THE PROMISE FULFILLED

Fast forward to Jesus.

He carried His cross up another hill in that same mountain ridge — Golgotha, outside the city walls. Like Isaac, Jesus carried the wood. But this time, no voice says "Stop!" Instead, the Father gives His only Son — for you and me.

"Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29)

Look to Calvary. The Lamb has come. The Father did not hold back His Son — He won't hold back His goodness for you.

He who did not spare His own Son but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also... graciously give us all things?" (Romans 8:32)

PRAYER


